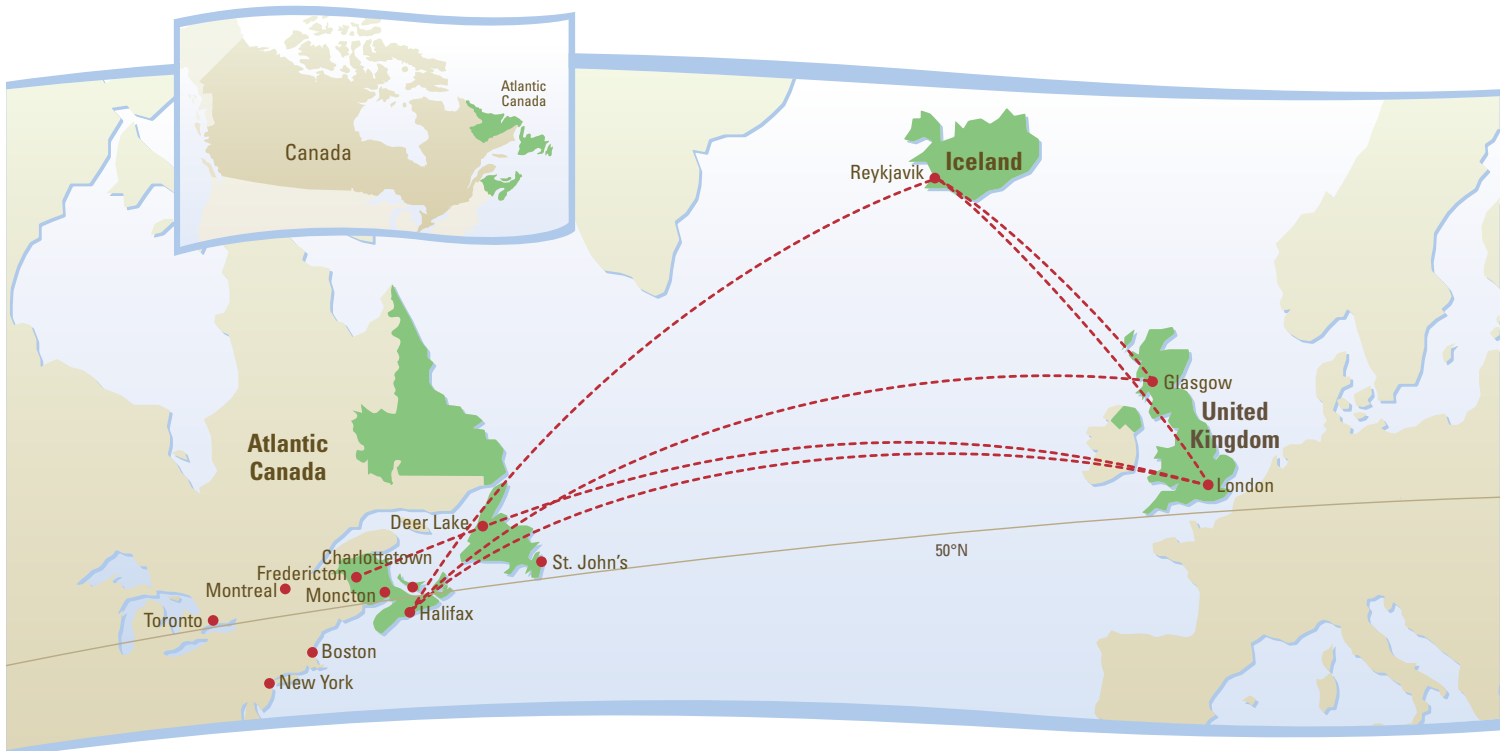


You haven't experienced Canada until you visit Atlantic Canada

Airline schedules are subject to change, please visit FlyHalifax.com or the airlines' websites for the latest flight schedules. Some of the flights indicated operate year round and some are seasonal. Flight Schedule current as of February, 2009.

UK to Halifax, Nova Scotia:

- Air Canada: Daily non-stop from London, Heathrow starting April 2009.
- Canadian Affair (Air Transat/Thomas Cook): Weekly seasonal service, non-stop from London Gatwick (May-Oct.).
- FlyGlobespan: Weekly seasonal service, non-stop from Glasgow (May-Nov.)
- Icelandair: Three flights a week (April-Oct.), Two flights a week (Nov.-April) direct from London, Heathrow or Glasgow via Reykjavik, Iceland.

UK to Fredericton, New Brunswick:

- Canadian Affair (Air Transat/Thomas Cook): Weekly seasonal direct from London, Gatwick (May-Oct.).

You can also access Atlantic Canada through Toronto, Montreal, Boston or New York. Check with your tour operator or travel agent for all options.
